#### Carrying Case

#### Pocket 1 "Major Injury"

- 3 - Sterile Pad 2" x 2"
- 2 - Stretch Roller Gauze 3" x 4 yd
- 4 - Sterile Eye Pad
- 1 - Absorbent Compress 5" x 9"
- 2 - Sterile 3" x 3" Gauze Pads
- 2 - Sterile 4" x 4" Gauze Pads
- 1 - Waterproof Adhesive Tape (1/2" x 2.5 yds)
- 1 - Triangular Bandage
- 2 - Latex Free Gloves (pr)

#### Pocket 2 "Minor Injury"

- 95 - Junior Band-aids 3/8x1 1/2
- 50 - Spot Band-aids 5/8x5/8
- 70 - Adhesive Bandages 1" x 3"
- 3 - Knuckle Bandage
- 3 - Fingertip Bandage
- 1 - Elbow/Knee Large Bandage
- 2 - Non-Adherent Pad
- 1 - Waterproof Adhesive Tape (1/2" x 2.5 yd)
- 4 - Wound Closure Strips (Butterfly) 2 ea
- 5 - Antiseptic Wound Cleaning Wipes
